

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR RETAIL GAS STATION

The Department of Planning and Natural Resources-Division of Environmental (DPNR-DEP) is providing this notice pursuant to 12 VIR&R 654-28 (a).

Husam Abdel Samad has submitted an application with DPNR-DEP for a permit to construct a retail gas station that utilizes an underground storage tank system at **Parcel 6 Rem. Estate Nadir, St. Thomas, VI 00803**. The proposed capacity is 30,000 gallons.

This notice is to advise the public, especially property owners within a 500 feet radius of the proposed gas station that a 45-day public comment period commences as of November 1, 2016. Also on **December 1, 2016 at 6 pm** at **DPNR main conference (second floor of the Cyril E. King Airport)** DPNR-DEP will host a public hearing to inform interested persons on the proposed UST system and to discuss any environmental impacts on the surroundings. Any persons who feels that granting of the application would be detrimental to his rights may appear at the public hearing and state his objections.
