The Department of Planning and Natural Resources-Division of Environmental Protection (DPNR-DEP) Air Pollution Control program received a renewal Title V of the Clean Air Act application from:

**The Sugar Bay Resort and Spa
6500 Estate Smith Bay
St. Thomas, VI 00802**

The application is for the operation of the following diesel generators located 6500 Estate Smith:

- **One Stationary Four stroke cycle diesel generator for electric power production, 1,370 ekW, 1,908 BHP, Caterpillar model # 3516B, S/N GZT00116 Alternator serial # 9MZ00292**
- **One 11,370 ekW, 1,908 BHP, Caterpillar model #3516B, S/N GZT00117 Alternator Serial #9MZ00291**
- **One 2,000 ekW, 2,937 BHP, Caterpillar model, #3516C S/N S BJ00310**

During operation, the units will emit particulates, nitrogen oxide, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide and hydrocarbons into the atmosphere. Sugar Bay Resort and Spa has the potential to emit more than 100 tons of NOx qualifying the resort as a Major Title V source.
