Documents needed for boat renewal registration:

1. Copy of prior year boat registration card(s) and mooring card(s).
2. Check or Money Order ONLY Payable to DPNR. NO CASH
3. Telephone number on the check or money order.
4. Self-addressed stamped envelope.

PLEASE NOTE

This fee schedule is pursuant to Title 25, Chapter 15 of the Virgin Islands Code. Payment can be made by bank drafts, certified checks, money orders, traveler's checks and personal checks.

Duplicate registration \$10.00 Transfers are \$5.00.

Mooring Fees: The lengths of the vessel multiply by \$5 dollars. Its \$25 for every month it is late.

Multi Mooring Fees: The Length of the Largest Vessel Multiply by \$5.00 multiply by 4(min) or the amount of Vessels listed 12 (Maximum)..
