What We Do



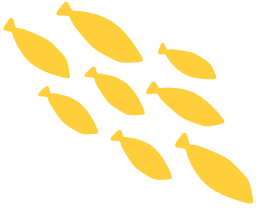
FISHERIES MANAGEMENT

Register 900+ recreational & commercial fishers

Enter 1200+ Commercial Catch Report into a national database annually

Conduct ~75 scientific sea life surveys annually

Measure an average of 155 fish at fishing tournaments



WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

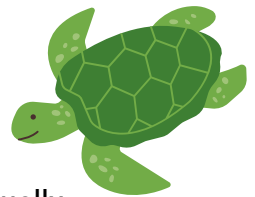
Respond to a dozen public wildlife incidents monthly

Coordinate a network of 45 rapid response volunteers

Support 2 local artists to design educational murals annually

Collaborate with local and international scientists

Manage 32 offshore cays for endangered species, invasive species, and migratory birds



RECREATION

Maintain 22 moorings,
3 FADs,
4 boat access points

Provide educational materials for
restaurants and fishers



Fund 400 kayak ecotours
to children annually



Teach 800+ FREE archery
lessons annually

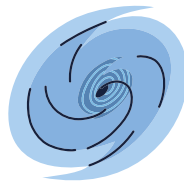
TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

pet owners annually

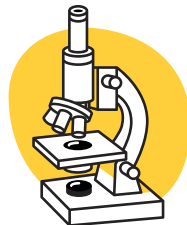
Mentor ~10 high school and
