At our meeting on February 25, 2025, the St. Croix Historic Preservation Committee of the VI Historic Preservation Commission reviewed and approved your application for partial demolition at 23 Market St. and 38A, 38B, 37, and 36 Company St., and 23 King St., Christiansted.

The Committee approves the demolition of all non-historic structures on the site, as well as the overall conceptual design for the project as presented. This is a project of the St. Croix Foundation for Community Development & will serve as a FEMA Safe Room during disaster events. It will also be a performing arts and community center for daily use. Based on the available lots presented, the parking requirement will be met with 79 spaces.
